I am writing to you today to request a meeting to discuss critical issues faced by your constituents.

As you are aware, in 2009 Ontario's MPPs unanimously passed the Poverty Reduction Act. Poverty affects all of us and it is important that the government and MPPs takes steps to reduce and eventually eradicate poverty for all. Even though 19,000 fewer children live in poverty now with the help of the first poverty reduction strategy to reduce child poverty by 25% in 5 years, hundreds and thousands of children still have to deal with the harsh realities of living on low income. Within our own community, we have children whose parents cannot afford to pay for even one meal a day on occasion, who struggle to pay for appropriate winter clothing, who cannot afford to pay for field trips, school stationary, and birthday presents - things that no child should have to do without. Moreover, many of these parents work an equivalent of full-time, full year in low paid, precarious jobs.

The overall unemployment rate in our (city/region) of (x%) and the youth unemployment rate of (x%) is of grave concern. We have xxx low income households in our city/region waiting for affordable housing and they can expect to wait x years before finding suitable accommodation. The problematic state of childcare funding and services, too, is of concern - particularly as young parents on modest- to lowincome are really struggling with finding affordable, high quality childcare for their children which in turn affects their transition into the labour market. We need to start tackling the social and economic issues of today for the benefit of future generations. I am extremely concerned that the level of poverty in our community and in our province will only get worse if most of the recommendations made by the Drummond Commission are adopted, and that this increase in poverty will have a further detrimental impact on our economy.

I want to further discuss these pressing issues with you and bring forward recommendations on tackling poverty on behalf of our constituency and in our province. Please contact me at (phone number) or (email address) to set up a date and time for this meeting.

Citizens engage local MPP on harsh realities of poverty in constituency

Today, a group of concerned citizens met with XX, MPP to voice their concerns around the issue of poverty in the constituency, and to warn against the negative impact that the Ontario government's economic decisions will have on the community's social and economic well-being.

The group, who are also involved in (Ontario Campaign 2000/Alliance for a Poverty Free Toronto), raised their concerns on the rate of unemployment in the area/province, the impact that current government cuts have had on youth, and the lack of affordable housing/childcare in the area that deters modest- and lowincome residents from pursuing good jobs. The group's main message at the meeting was that the economy will only do well if we, as families and as members of civil society, are able to pursue a decent standard of living – which is far from the case right now.

PRIORITIZE POVERTY REDUCTION

What Ontario Needs to Do

- → Provide adequate funding for programs affiliated with the poverty reduction strategy
- → Introduce targets and timelines for the eradication of child poverty in Ontario

ENCOURAGE GOOD JOBS AT LIVING WAGES

What Ontario Needs to Do

- → Increase minimum wage to \$11/hour in 2012 & fully index to inflation
- → Address workplace discrimination: implement Employment Equity program; ensure pay equity

PROVIDE A STRONG SOCIAL SAFETY NET

What Ontario Needs to Do

- → Fully index social assistance rates to inflation & transform social assistance to support movement out of poverty; Ensure high quality training programs to support the move from welfare to work, and layoff to work
- → Increase maximum Ontario Child Benefit to \$125 a month
- → Introduce \$100 monthly Healthy Food Supplement for all adults on social assistance.

ENSURE ACCESS TO EARLY LEARNING & CHILD CARE

What Ontario Needs to Do

- → The 2012 budget must allocate \$287 million in emergency funding to prevent the closure of hundreds of child care centres across Ontario
- → Issue a moratorium on licensing of new for-profit child care centres.
- → Commit to developing policies and a new funding model to support affordable high quality child care.

IMPROVE ACCESS TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING

What Ontario Needs to Do

- → Invest to bring aging social housing stock up to standard, build more affordable housing and new supportive housing
- → Provide a monthly Housing Benefit to low-income tenants to reduce high rent costs
